# Absence

### **DAILY ABSENCE**

If your child is ill, parents are requested to email the class teacher or reception@pearlbritishacademy.ae before 7.30am on the first day of absence. One day of absence due to illness will be authorised. If your child is absent due to illness for more than one day, we require a medical certificate authorised by a doctor.

### **MONITORING ATTENDANCE**

Your child's class teacher is responsible for monitoring your child's daily attendance. If your child's attendance becomes a cause for concern, Mr Marcroft, Head of Pastoral Care, will contact you to discuss ways forward.

### EARLY DEPARTURE FROM SCHOOL

We request that you do not collect your child early from school. In the case where this is unavoidable (for example a medical appointment where an after-school time was not available), we ask you to inform your child's class teacher at least one day before early collection is required. Parents are asked to present the medical appointment card to support the need for the appointment to be made during the school day. Parents should complete an Early Collection Form, which should be emailed to reception@pearlbritishacademy.ae in advance.

### PLANNED ABSENCE DURING TERM

Please note that the school does not authorise holidays taken during the term. Requests for authorised absence must be made on a Request for Absence Form given to the School PA, at least seven days in advance for the principal's approval.

We continue our successful Bring Your Own Device (BYOD) initiative.

Children in Years 2 to 6 bring their own device to school every day and use it for planned educational purposes throughout the day.

Children in EYFS and Year 1 have access to the school's iPads.

### Email

Please ensure the school has your correct email address. Teachers and school management will communicate through email.

The first port of call for any issues at all in school is your child's class teacher.

If your child's teacher is not able to assist you, they will put you in touch with someone who can.







All children will have a Seesaw account, which parents can access.

Login information will be sent home in the first weeks of school.

Seesaw is a communication tool between the class teacher and parents through which teachers will:

- ✓ Share photos of children's learning
- ✓ Write a weekly update about children's learning
- Share information regarding trips and events in school
- ✓ Message parents informally

Additional and replacement for lost cards will be subjected to 50 dhs fees. Please collect your lanyard from the school receptionist.











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
